Position Summary:

Apply operations research (cost management and analysis) techniques to estimate costs for Army programs and mission areas. Develop cost estimates, lifecycle cost analysis and economic analysis and metrics related to weapons systems, personnel, communications systems, installations, operations, force structure and more. Develop policies, methods and models to support Army cost management programs and information systems.

Required Skills:

Candidates must have a Bachelor's degree with 24 semester hours of quantitative based courses including 3 semester hours of Calculus.

Senior level analysts require experience and subject matter expertise. Mid-level staff analysts require experience, knowledge, skills and abilities relevant to the performance of Army analyses, primarily cost analysis. Entry/Support level analysts must have the required quantitative background.

The ideal candidate will be proficient with Microsoft software packages and knowledge of costing/statistical software application packages is desirable. Must have good communication skills and work with minimal supervision.
