



## WHAT IS DRMI?

The Defense Resources Management Institute (DRMI) is located at the Naval Postgraduate School (NPS) in Monterey, California. Sponsored by the Secretary of Defense, DRMI has conducted professional education programs in analytical decision-making and resources management since 1965. DRMI faculty design courses for U. S. and international military officers and senior civilian officials; participants have come from more than 160 countries (including the United States.) A graduate-level faculty presents these programs in Monterey on a regularly-scheduled basis; courses are also available by specific arrangement in other locations both in the United States and overseas.

The goal of DRMI's programs is to enhance the effective allocation and use of scarce resources in modern defense organizations by developing participants' analytical decision-making skills. DRMI faculty teach key concepts in management, economics and quantitative reasoning. In addition, the DRMI curriculum uses real-world cases in contexts that include contemporary issues.

DRMI's dedicated faculty teach all DRMI programs. The diverse faculty have extensive experience in defense resources management and in the management of complex defense organizations.



## TRADITIONAL RESIDENT COURSES

### DEFENSE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT COURSE (MASL P162002)

For U.S. and international officers O-4 to O-6 and equivalent civilians (four weeks, with an option to take in two two-week segments; offered five times per year at the Naval Postgraduate School)

DRMC participants may apply for graduate credit (four quarter hours in management) through the NPS Registrar. The DRMC also qualifies the participant for 116 hours of continuing education in financial management.

### INTERNATIONAL DEFENSE MANAGEMENT COURSE (MASL P162003)

For international officers O-4 to O-6 and equivalent civilians (11 weeks; offered twice per year at NPS)

### SENIOR INTERNATIONAL DEFENSE MANAGEMENT COURSE (MASL P162004)

For international flag and general officers and senior civilian officials (four weeks; offered once per year at NPS)

#### NOTES:

- DRMI may grant rank waivers upon request.
- Non DoD-sponsored individuals may attend upon request.

## NEW RESIDENT COURSES

All of these are intended for U.S. and international officers, O-4 and above, and equivalent civilians. Each course's date allows for a longer period of study when paired with a Defense Resources Management Course.



### MULTIPLE CRITERIA DECISION MAKING COURSE (MASL P162012)

Two weeks

### STREAMLINING GOVERNMENT THROUGH OUTSOURCING, PRIVATIZATION AND PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS COURSE (MASL P162011)

One week

### BUDGET PREPARATION, EXECUTION AND ACCOUNTABILITY COURSE (MASL P156600)

Eight days

### RISK MANAGEMENT COURSE (MASL P162000)

Two weeks

## MOBILE COURSES

### MOBILE INTERNATIONAL DEFENSE MANAGEMENT COURSE (MASL P319016)

Upon request from host nation (one or two weeks). Traditional focus is on developing analytical frameworks to improve the allocation of scarce defense resources, but courses can be tailored to meet specific host nation needs—for instance, courses may focus on any of the topic areas of our new resident courses (see panel to left). Taught in host nation language, using interpreters as necessary.

### SPECIAL PROGRAMS

Upon request, DRMI has the ability to conduct special programs (seminars, surveys, workshops, and conferences) in resources management.
